The BIBLICAL LANGUAGE of "TWICE SPEAK" for THE LAST DAY CHURCH

Scripture teaches that there is indeed a "secret" last day biblical language of "twice speak." It is even specifically identified as a Bible "doctrine." Most of all, is an inseparable part of the final seventh day Sabbath "rest" experience of "righteousness by faith" and the reception of "the "refreshing" or "latter rain." Yet church leaders will "not perceive" and "not hear" this truth according to the prophecies of Job 33:12-17 and Isaiah 28:7-19.

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THE LAST DAY CHURCH

11 Twice Speak Truth #1: <u>Yahweh</u> "<u>speaks</u>" to us through his "<u>Word</u>" to "<u>heal</u>" and "<u>sanctify</u>" 12 us:

<u>Eze_12:25</u> For I *am* the <u>LORD</u>: <u>I will speak</u>, and <u>the word</u> that I shall <u>speak</u> [prophesy]<u>shall</u> <u>come to pass</u>; it shall be no more prolonged: for in your days, O rebellious house, <u>will I say</u> <u>the word, and will perform it</u>, saith the Lord GOD. [Compare with Genesis 41:32 below on "bring it to pass.]

18 Psa 68:11 The Lord gave the word: great was the company of those that published *it*.

20 2Ti 3:16 All <u>scripture</u> *is* given by inspiration of <u>God</u>, and *is* profitable for doctrine, for 21 reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:

- 23 Psa 119:105 **Thy word** *is* a lamp unto my feet, and a light unto my path.
- 25 Jer 1:4 Then the word of the LORD came unto me, saying,

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Joh 17:14 <u>I</u> have given them <u>thy word</u>; and the world hath hated them, because they are not of the world, even as <u>I</u> am not of the world.

Mat 8:8 The centurion **answered** and **said**, **Lord**, I am not worthy that thou shouldest come under my roof: but **speak the word only**, and my servant shall be **healed**.

34 35 36	Twice Speak Truth #2: <u>Miraculously</u> , but <u>unknown</u> to most, whenever Yahweh " <u>speaks</u> " through his " <u>Word</u> " – his "Word" secretly " <u>speaks</u> " not " <u>once</u> " but " <u>twice</u> " and sometimes " <u>thrice</u> ":

39 40 41	[In this verse Elihu, who according to Job 33:6 is standing "in God's stead" to Job, is teaching and answering Job regarding this most important "Twice" "speak" truth]

44 45 46	[In other words, why do we think we know so much? See, 1Corinthians 8:2.] for he giveth not [no]account of any of his matters.
47 48 49	[So, Yahweh now tells us in the remainder of this passage how he indeed "is greater than man."]
49 50 51	Job 33:14 For God <u>speaketh</u> once, yea <u>twice</u> , yet <u>man perceiveth it not</u> .
52 53	[This prophetic truth is not perceived because it is a very secret last day truth].
54 55 56	Job 33:15 In a dream, in a vision of the night, when deep sleep falleth upon men, in slumberings upon the bed;
57 58 59	[For instance, see Daniel 2 and 7 for how so many of the words of Job 33:9-17 and Job 11:5-6 are repeated in the "sealed" book of Daniel.]
60 61	Job 33:16 Then he openeth the ears of men, and sealeth their instruction,
62 63 64	[See Amos 3:7-8 and Revelation 10:3 and 7 where the "secret of God" is repeated and finally roared.]
65 66 67	Job 33:17 That he may withdraw man <i>from his</i> purpose [Yahweh's "secret" mode of <i>operation throughout all Scripture</i>], and hide pride from man.
68 69	Job 33:29 Lo, all these <i>things</i> worketh God <u>oftentimes</u> [The margin says " <u>thrice.</u> "] with man
70 71 72	[Thus Yahweh miraculously "speaks" not only "once," but "twice" and sometimes "thrice" throughout all Scripture],
73 74 75	Job 33:30 To bring back his soul from the pit [to literally save our lives by the knowledge of this "secret" "doctrine"], to be enlightened with the light of the living.
75 76 77	Psa 62:11 God hath spoken once ; twice have I heard this; that power <i>belongeth</i> unto God.

- 78 [This "power" is unquestionably "revealed" in how all Scripture miraculously "speaks" 79 not "once" but "twice" and sometimes "thrice"]. 80 81 Gen 41:32 And for that the dream was doubled unto Pharaoh twice; it is because the thing is 82 established by God, and God will shortly bring it to pass. 83 84 Job 40:5 Once have I spoken; but I will not answer. [This is because it is a special "secret," which is not "revealed" until our day according to Amos 3:3-8 and Revelation 10:71: yea. 85 twice; but I will proceed no further *[until the time of "the seventh angel when he shall begin* 86 87 to sound]." 88 89 [It should be kept in mind that "the seventh angel" of Revelation 1:7 is the "mighty angel" 90 which causes Satan's entire kingdom of Babylon the Great to fall via the "revealing" of 91 and "roaring" of this "secret" and most powerful last day truth. The fact that "the secret "revealed" and is now being "declared" means that "the seventh 92 of God" has now been angel" of Revelation 10:7 93 has indeed, already begun "to sound." This "doctrine" is 94 this important.] 95 Twice Speak Truth #3: Thus the secrets of Yahweh's lips are always double to that which is: 96 Job 11:5 But oh that God would speak, and open his lips against thee; [so he can whisper 97 "the secret of God" in the ear "of them that fear him;" Ps. 25:14.] 98 Job 11:6 And that he would shew thee the secrets of wisdom, that they are double to that 99 which is! 100 Job 4:12 Now a thing was secretly brought to me, and mine ear received a little thereof *lof* 101 how Yahweh speaks "once"]. 102 103 Pro 8:6 Hear; for I will speak of excellent things; and the opening of my lips shall be right 104 things. [When a person is "rightly dividing the word of truth," as Yahweh commands us to 105 "Study" "all Scripture," 2 Tim. 2:15, they are wisely discerning the difference between how 106 Yahweh "speaks once" and how Yahweh "speaks twice."] 107 108 Deu 29:29 The secret things belong unto the LORD our God: but those things which are revealed belong unto us and to our children for ever, that we may do all the words of this law. 109 110 111 Twice Speak Truth #4: Yahweh speaks with "stammering lips" when he speaks not "once" but "twice." 112 With the above three principles in mind of how Yahweh speaks not once but twice through his 113 Word-please notice how almost every word and or phrase, in the famous following "Twice 114
- Speak" passage of Isaiah 28:7-18, is mysteriously spoken not "once," but "twice," and sometimes

"thrice." As we shall see, this is how Yahweh indeed speaks "with stammering lips," because 116 "the secrets of wisdom" from "his lips" are always "double to that which is," as Job 11:5-6 has 117 118 just told us. Most importantly-but unknown to most-this chapter unquestionably and inseparably links this 119 "Twice Speak" truth with the reception of the final seventh day Sabbath "rest" of righteousness 120 by faith (Hebrews 3-4) and the "refreshing" or outpouring of the "latter rain." Thus the failure to 121 fully embrace this "doctrine" and its inherent life and death teachings could not have more 122 serious ramifications. 123 124 Isa 28:7 But they [the priest and the prophet or today's spiritual thought leaders] also have erred through wine *[false doctrine]*, and through strong drink are out of the way; the priest 125 and the prophet have erred through strong drink, they are swallowed up of wine, they are out 126 of the way through strong drink; they err in vision, they stumble in judgment. 127 128 Additional comment: This is because today's spiritual thought leaders don't know how 129 130 "God speaketh once, yea twice, yet man perceiveth it not. In a dream, in a vision," Job 33:14-15. Thus Hosea 4:6 faithfully warns: "My people are destroyed for lack of 131 knowledge: because thou hast rejected knowledge, I will also reject thee, that thou shalt 132 133 be no priest to me:" 134 135 Jer 2:8 The **priests** said not, Where is the LORD? and they that handle the law *[and who* have changed the Ten Commandments knew me not: the **pastors** also transgressed against 136 me, and the prophets prophesied by Baal [Sunday worship of Satan the pagan sun god on 137 his day of worship], and walked after things that do not profit. 138 139 140 Jer 10:21 For the **pastors** are become brutish, and have not sought the LORD: therefore they shall not prosper, and all their flocks shall be scattered [The Christian faith is 141 dying.]. 142 143 Jer 12:10 Many pastors have destroyed my vineyard, they have trodden my portion under 144 foot, they have made my pleasant portion a desolate wilderness. 145 146 147 Jer 22:22 The wind shall eat up all thy pastors, and thy lovers shall go into captivity: surely then shalt thou be ashamed and confounded for all thy wickedness. 148 149 150 Jer 23:1 Woe be unto the **pastors** that destroy and scatter the sheep of my pasture! saith the LORD. 151 152 153 Jer 23:2 Therefore thus saith the LORD God of Israel against the **pastors** that feed my people: Ye have scattered my flock, and driven them away, and have not visited them: 154 behold, I will visit upon you the evil of your doings, saith the LORD. 155 156

171	Yahweh's Word does indeed speak "twice." Thus Isaiah 28 asks:

184 185	Iso 29:12 To whom he said This is the rest ["This" "destrine" of "This Surply" Id
185 186	Isa 28:12 To whom he said, <u>This is the rest</u> ["This" "doctrine" of "Twice Speak" and the life and death truths that it clearly teaches] is therefore the true, final Sabbath "rest" of
187	righteousness by faith of Hebrews 3-47 wherewith ye may cause the weary to rest; and this is
188	the <u>refreshing</u> [the outpouring of the "latter rain," which refreshes the crops just before the
189	harvest, Hosea 6:3, Joel 2:23, James 5:7]: yet they would not hear.
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191	Acts 3:19 Repent ye therefore, and be converted, that your sins may be blotted out, when the
192	times of refreshing shall come from the presence of the Lord ;
193	
194 105	1Co 14:21 In the <u>law</u> it is written, With <i>men of <u>other tongues</u></i> and other lips will I speak unto

197	This is why Deuteronomy 32:2 proclaims: "My <u>doctrine</u> shall <u>drop as the rain</u> , my <u>speech</u> shall

199	Nevertheless Isaiah 28:10 is perfectly repeated, not "once" but "twice" that no one may have any
200	excuse not to know how Yahweh speaks "with stammering lips and another tongue," Isaiah 28:11,
201	to his rebellious last day "scornful men" or religious leaders who refuse to learn this last day "secret
202	of God" truth, repeated over and over:

Twice Speak Truth #5: Yahweh speaks with "another tongue" or language when he speaks not "once" but "twice.

- Isa 28:11 For with stammering lips [Yah, Yah, does, does, not, not, speak, speak, once, once,
 but, but, twice, twice and, and, sometimes, sometimes, thrice.] and another tongue [the
 "tongue" or "language" of "Twice Speak"] will he speak to this people.
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- Therefore, because a spoken "tongue" is a language, Scripture teaches that the "another tongue" of "Twice Speak" is indeed a secret yet fully bonafide, easily demonstrated, last day biblical language.
- Twice Speak Truth #6: Whenever Yahweh "speaks," something is "done." Thus His word
 never returns unto him void.
- Psa 33:9 For he spake, and it was done ["Yahweh speaks once"]; he commanded, and it stood fast ["Yahweh speaks twice"].
- Isa 55:11 So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me
 yoid, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper *in the thing* whereto I
 sent it.
- Eze 12:25 For I *am* the LORD: I will <u>speak</u>, and the <u>word</u> that I shall <u>speak</u> shall <u>come to</u>
 pass; it shall be no more prolonged: for in your days, O rebellious house, will I <u>say</u> the <u>word</u>,

286	antitype. The "type" is when Yahweh "speaks once" which is the first incomplete,
287	imperfect fulfillment.

289	Key definition: An antitype is always the perfect, complete, "greater," primary event,
290	truth or prophecy to which the type always points and is trying to teach.
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292 293 294 295 296 297 298	The prefix, anti- as in <u>anti-</u>type , is simply a Greek preposition meaning " <u>instead of</u> " or " <u>in place of</u> ." Thus, when the <u>antitype</u> is finally placed in " <u>place of</u> " the " <u>type</u> ," this <u>antitypical</u> fulfillment is when Yahweh "speaks twice." It is the much greater, secret, second, primary and complete fulfillment. Thus the type or typical fulfillment is always a kind of <u>prophetic charade</u> acting out a most important, secret, perfect, primary, complete, "greater," event, truth or prophecy for our day.

390	It is because of this that Christ privately instructed his very closest followers, who
391	were being initiated into his kingdom: [Emphasis supplied.] The counterfeit of this
392	truth is how Satan likewise initiates his subjects into his pagan mystery religions and

400	In other words, there are numerous "mysteries" or "secrets," Daniel 2:47, in the Judaeo-
401	Christian H1113 religion. But more—there is a special "secret" or "mystery" that is above
402	and beyond all of them. H1114 This fabulous "secret" is only for those who are seeking
403 404	for our Saviour with all their hearts and H1115 who are determined to follow him at all
404	costs. It is they alone who are worthy of it!

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Therefore these self-deceived teachers who don't even understand the "milk" of the Word are unquestionably "<u>unskillful in the word of righteousness</u>" and <u>cannot accurately "discern" the</u> <u>difference between "both good and evil.</u>" Thus, according to Scripture, and unless they speedily repent, they are unquestionably disqualified from the ministry and are a large reason why the church is in such serious apostasy today. They are also a large reason why so many are unnecessarily lost and don't know it. Accordingly Paul warns of these false teachers:
